**NARRATIVE**

On 08/01/2022 at approximately 2236 hours, I was dispatched to 400 Sunny Isles Blvd in reference to an auto theft.

Upon arrival, I made contact with [REDACTED] Daniel (VI), who stated that he arrived from the airport today and noticed his White 2021 Lamborghini Urus [REDACTED] was missing. VI stated he is the owner of the vehicle, and was in good standing with payments. The last time he saw his vehicle was approximately two weeks ago from today's date. VI stated he left for a trip on 07/22/2022 at approximately 1630 hours and returned on today's date at approximately 2200 hours. VI stated when he went to check on his vehicle, it was not there. VI stated he had nothing of value inside the vehicle when it was stolen. VI then called the police.

There is CCTV surveillance available of the incident. The CCTV shows that on 07/24/2022, at approximately 1324 hours, the vehicle's headlights turned on. Then, at approximately 1327 hours, CCTV shows the vehicle driving away with an unknown person driving. CCTV surveillance does not offer any description of OF. I took a video of the CCTV surveillance and sent it via email to property.

The building has a separate Valet that can provide better CCTV footage of the incident. CCTV can be seen during business hours Monday-Friday from 1000 hours to 1700 hours.

The vehicle was entered into NCIC/FCIC as stolen on 08/02/2022, 0007hrs, by dispatcher L. Mendoza.

VI filled out a Stolen Vehicle Affidavit which was turned in with this report.

A Property Receipt was filled out, and a Teletype was turned in with this report.

VI was issued a case number.

On August 3, 2022 I was assigned this Grand Theft Auto case #22-01900 for investigation.

I entered the stolen vehicles temporary tag DFF6728 into the LPR's which showed on July 24, 2022 the vehicle was driving westbound over the William Lehman Causeway at 1348 hrs. The Vehicle last hit on July 27, 2022 on High Meadows Ave and I95 at 1501 hrs (Palm City, Martin County). There have been no hits since this date.

I then attempted to call the Victim, Daniel David in order to verify the facts in the report, however the telephone was disconnected.

On August 10, 2022 the vehicle was entered into NCIC/FCIC which verified that the vehicle was still listed as stolen.

On August 11, 2022 CCTV was reviewed which showed the vehicle leaving parking garage, however I was unable to obtain any suspect information.

Investigation revealed an additional phone number that was listed for the Victim 718-790-6665. I attempted to make call that number however there was no answer.

Due to the CCTV not revealing any suspect information and not being able to make contact with the Victim, David Daniel this case will be classified as PENDING/INACTIVE reference any investigative leads.
