NARRATIVE

We responded to 400 Sunny Isles Beach Blvd in emergency mode in reference to a subject who was possibly overdosing on acid. Jake Warner, (IO), chartered a pontoon boat with friends. During their trip, he took LSD and mushrooms. Upon returning to the dock he was hallucinating, disoriented and combative. Hannah Gale, (RP), said Jake started hallucinating and jumped into the water. She and the others on the boat pulled him out of the water. Once back on the boat he became combative and hit his head on a dock piling. They held him down until Police arrived. We handcuffed him for safety reasons. Miami-Dade Fire Rescue 10 responded under the command of Lt Batista and transported him to Aventura Hospital. Alarm #2141236. He was attended to by Dr Grekoski and Nurse Jaylene. Jake suffered minor self-inflicted abrasions to his forehead and knees. Jake and Hannah are on vacation from Portland, Oregon and are staying at an Airbnb.
